

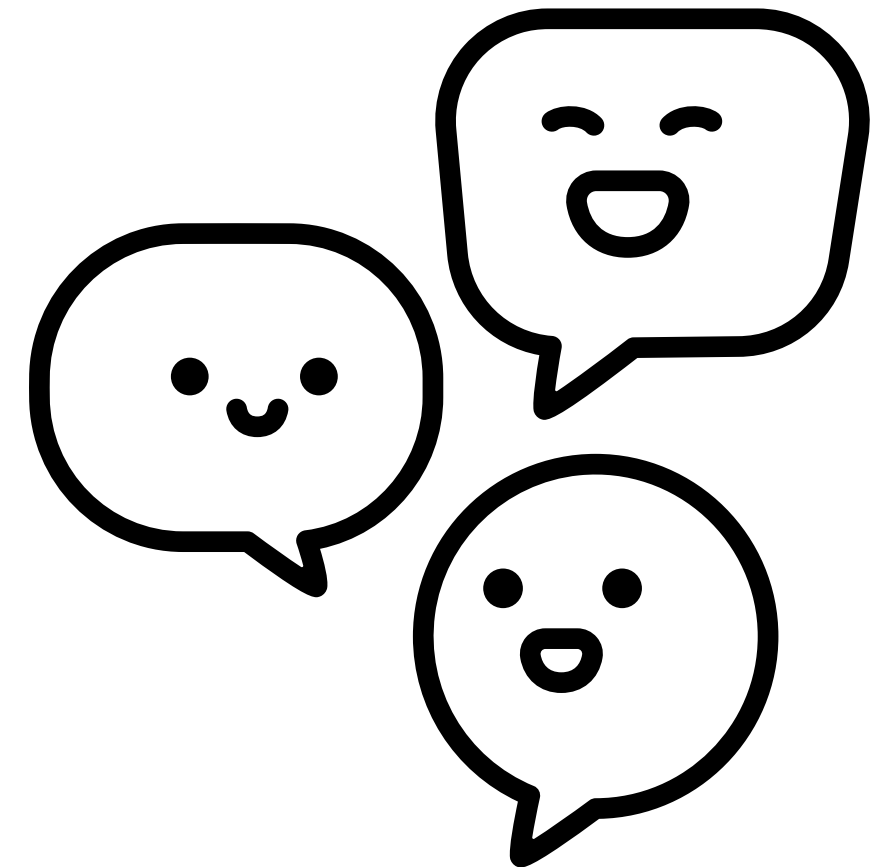

# Outline

- Use this approach to unleash creative ideas that are not tethered to the here and now.
- In this activity you imagine that the meeting is taking place in the future (10 years ahead or the end of the next NPO – which ever suits you)
- You imagine that you are in that time (e.g. 2031) and you acclimatise the group by asking them what the major changes are in society in the last decade.
- Having explored these ideas (which are of course creative speculations and inventions) we then focus in on how the organization, it's work, practices, audiences, staff and impacts have changed in the last decade
- Having painted a picture of a different future, we then ask people to describe the journey – what made the most difference in the last 10 years, what would you say the tipping points were etc.
- Once we 'return to the present' we then sift through the conversations and speculations that happened for those that we want to hold on to, investigate further or that feel significant.
